


Use these symbols to create your flowchart.




The oval is used as the starting point. The starting point can lead to any one of the options below: a document, a step, or a decision.



This shape represents a document. For this assignment, this symbol will lead to either a process or a decision.



The rectangle is used to show a step in the process. These show us individual steps, what happens second, what happens third, etc. They can lead you to a decision, the termination point, or a document.



The diamond is used to show that a decision must be made. Decisions are usually an either/or, such as “yes” or “no.” A decision will lead to another step in the process or to a termination point.



Finally, an oval is also used to represent the end. It is a termination point. This symbol is used at all termination points, not just the very end.



The Arrows are used to connect each point in the flowchart.
